*All coaches must be certified Level I (Club Coach) to compete at the PCA districts. All coaches must be certified Level II (except as noted below) to compete in an AB Provincial Championship (exception: Level 1 at Juvenile Provincials). With the above noted, it is the responsibility of the team to name a Level II coach immediately following a berth to a provincial championship. (Junior teams without a certified coach will be disqualified from participating at the subject provincial championship.)

Note: A Level I may coach one year provided a Level II coach as a preceptor accompanies them.

****Coaches of junior aged teams must have completed the “Coach’s Screening” which includes a criminal check a minimum of 5 days prior to the entry deadline. The Coach’s Screening application form is available on our website www.peacecurl.org or through the office. Each screening is valid for five years.**

TEAM DECLARATION:

One team member (with junior aged teams, this must be the coach) must sign the declaration below in order for the team entry to be accepted.

On behalf of Team _____, I declare that:

- a minimum of two (2) players are members in good standing with an affiliated curling club of the Peace Curling Association and all members are in good standing with an affiliated curling club within the jurisdiction of the Alberta Curling Federation.
- all team members are domiciled within the boundaries of the Alberta Curling Federation at least 30 days prior to the playdown category for which this entry applies;
- all team members are willing to compete in the district playdown and subsequent playdowns; except in the event of illness, accident, work related or other extenuating circumstances;
- should a substitute be required for any of the above reasons, we agree to comply with PCA substitution policy;
- all team members acknowledge that non-compliance with eligibility requirements by any team member will result in the team being ineligible to participate in or continuing to participate in the subject playdown;
- all team members agree to comply with the PCA Code of Conduct, all applicable rules of curling and applicable curling associations;
- we agree to pay the playdown fee prior to the start of the playdown.
