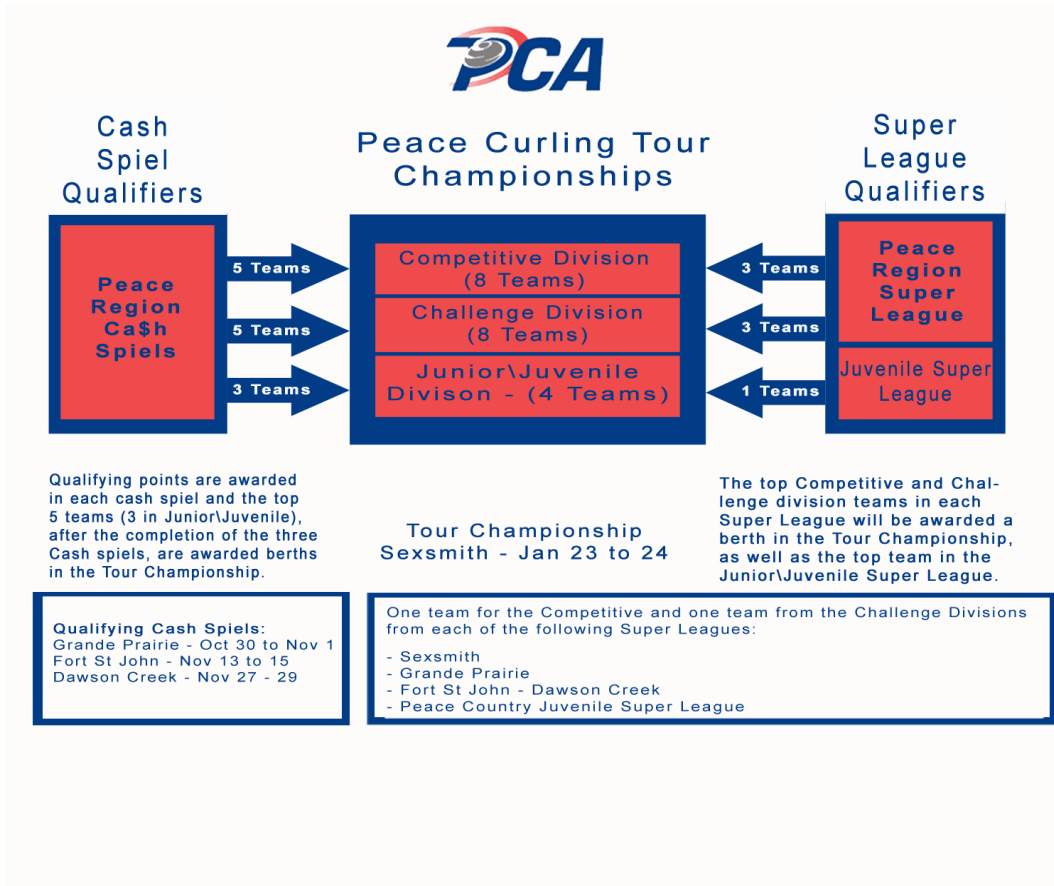

Each year the PCA sends 28 teams to Provincial Championships. The purpose of the Peace Curling Tour is to rejuvenate the interest in our Cash Spiels and Super Leagues so that competitive curlers in all categories have a local opportunity to develop their skills. The tour is also a great opportunity for any curlers looking to play for significant cash prizes.

Eight teams will qualify for the Tour Championship in both the Competitive and Challenge divisions while four teams will qualify in the Junior/Juvenile division (see illustration).



We encourage all of curlers and fans to support the Cash Spiels, Super Leagues and Tour Championship. Won't it be exciting to have 30 to 40 teams at a Cash Spiel?



Major sponsorships have been secured and are being finalized and 2 major launch events will be held in early October to announce our sponsors and to introduce the Tour and its Championship to the public. This advanced notice is being provided to all curlers to encourage your participation in all Cash Spiels.

As shown in the illustration on the previous page, the five teams that accumulate the most points from the Cash Spiels for their division will be joined at the Tour Championship by one team from each Super League to make up our field of eight for each Tour Championship division. In order to qualify for the Tour Championship in Sexsmith all teams must have played in a minimum of 2 of the cash spiels. This includes the teams qualifying through the super leagues.

Competitive and Challenge teams earn points in the Cash Spiels as per below:

- 2 points for attending a tour event (to be added to below)
- 2 points for C event finalist if there are 8 qualifiers
- 4 points for quarter finalists (or C event finalist if less than 8 qualifiers)
- 6 points for semi finalists
- 8 points for finalists
- 10 points for event winner

Points are nontransferable between divisions.

Teams must have played with a minimum of 2 players at a minimum of 2 tour events in order to qualify for the Tour Championship and any gender combination is acceptable.

The teams that qualify for this year's Tour Championship in Sexsmith will have the opportunity to play for significant prize money and the winners in each division will also receive Championship jackets. We have attached a standard entry form that can be used to enter all 3 Cash Spiels. Any entries received by the PCA will be forwarded to the individual Cash Spiels.

We encourage teams to start planning their 2009-2010 curling season and to include the cash spiels, super leagues and tour championship in your planning. We will be inviting curlers to attend the launch events and would appreciate your attendance to help successfully introduce our curling tour. In your planning, please be aware that each of the cash spiels will be a true triple knockout and therefore games will begin Friday during the day.
