The **Peace Curling Tour** incorporates 3 events.

PNG Juvenile Superleague

Cash prize of 10/point won. Cost is \$280 per team, max 8 games. A team can play one date, two dates, three or four. **Juvenile Super-league (JSL), you pick maximum 4 of 5 dates.** Games start at 10:30 and 1:30. 10 min warm up prior to first game. Two-1 min time outs permitted. No extra ends. The winner of the JSL will receive the PCA trophy, individual trophies, and team prize sponsored by PNG.

Age restrictions: 17 and under as of Dec 31. One player may be 18 but should not skip.

Canwest Peace Tour

Games will be played on Sunday. There are three locations. Two games will be played each date. No extra ends. Points only awarded. NOTE. Cost is free.

Age restriction: 20 and under as of Dec 31.

Canwest Arctic Cup

Teams will travel to a host community and play 4 games. Teams are invited from all across the north to participate. Points will go towards the Peace Tour. Extra ends will break ties.

Age restriction: 18 and under as of July 1 2011

Peace Tour Finals

The top **3** teams in total points of the three events will be granted access into the Peace Curl tour final in Sexsmith along with the winner of the JSL.

ALL GAMES ARE 8 ENDS

Ties at the end of the season for points will be broken by the team with the lowest skills competition. This will be determined by the best of two skills competitions. First is done at first game, and second on team's decision. If not done, than first try stands.

The winner of the Peace Tour will receive the Canwest Cup, team coats, and prize table.

In the event of a tie, those teams on the ABJC Tour, a draw to the button will be held to determine a win for ABJC tour points only.

Alberta Junior Curling Tour

All games on the Peace Tour qualify for points to teams participating in the Alberta Junior Curling Tour. Registration prior to each event is required in order for AJCT points to

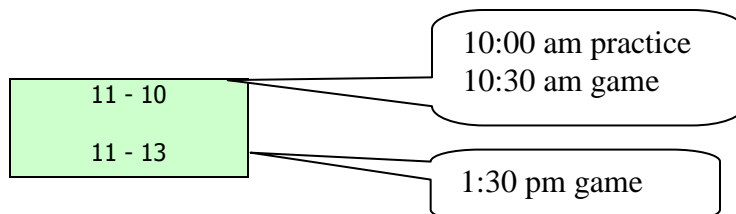
